Pre-registration is required by calling Cathy Meeres (Elementary Secretary) 1-800-663-3381 (ext.2448) or 604-794-2448. Leave a brief message with your child's name, grade and phone number. Your child's name will be added to the list of students who are interested in attending. Our teacher, Pat Gerlach, will contact you after the registration deadline to confirm your attendance.

Class size is limited to a maximum of 20 students. A second class may be added if there is sufficient interest. If enrolment is low, the class may be cancelled and you will be notified as soon as possible.

**At the beginning of the first session, parents are required to stay for a brief 15-minute orientation. During this time, we will review procedures and answer any questions that you may have. Parents must sign in each time they drop off and pick-up their children.** It is not necessary to stay with your child and unfortunately, due to lack of space, parents are asked to wait in the side room if they wish to remain on site. Please ensure that your child arrives to the event on time and dressed appropriately for the activity.

It is important for students to attend classes consistently. For students in grades 5-7, credit may be given for participation in drama, dance and music. Please contact your child's teacher to pre-arrange this.

We encourage you to take the opportunity to attend this production with your family and look forward to sharing these valuable educational experiences with you and your child.
